



ITF Cornish Imperial Taekwon-Do Championships – 6th June 2010

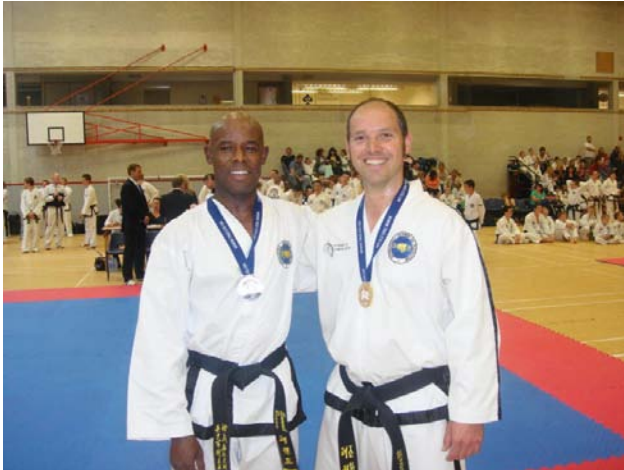
